Contest Rules

Baxter's Vineyards/Winery 16th Annual Amateur Wine Maker Contest awards will be held on Saturday June 26, 2010 at the Baxter's Vineyards.

The deadline to enter your wine for the competition is on Thursday, June 24, 2010 at 5:00 pm.

Eligibility:

Any wine maker who is over 21 years old and is not engaged in wine making for a profit is eligible to enter the contest.

***** Important: Please do not use sticky labels on your bottle(s). Attach a label with the kind of wine with rubber band. Wine must be in a 750mL bottle.**

Entries

1. Each wine entry shall be in a standard wine bottle, 750 ml. with all labels removed. One bottle of wine is required per exhibit and shall be the homemade product of the exhibitor.
2. The same wine may not be entered in more than one class.
3. A fee of \$5.00 per entry of wine will be charged and is non refundable. Make checks payable to: Baxter's Vineyards.

Scoring

A 20 point scoring system will be used for scoring each entry. The elements of the system and associated points are: clarity, smell, finish & overall quality.

Awards

1. Each wine maker will receive a certificate of participation.
2. First, Second and Third Place ribbons will be awarded in each class.
3. All wines awarded a first place ribbon will be judged again for the Best of Show award. The Best of Show winner will receive 10 gallons or \$75 worth of fresh juice available starting in September 2010 and a Baxter's Vineyards t-shirt.
